This year's Washington Youth Tour (WYT), to be held June 18-25, 2020, is a fast-paced, once-in-a-lifetime opportunity to experience our government and our history up-close-while still having fun, making new friends and gaining leadership skills.

Before departing for Washington, D.C., the students will spend a day in Atlanta, GA. While in Atlanta, the WYT Delegates will learn about Georgia's 41 EMC's and the electric cooperative industry. While in Washington, the students will join approximately 1,500 young people who will be representing rural electric cooperatives from all across the United States. Highlights of the stay in our nation's capital will include cruising down the Potomac River, placing a wreath on the Tomb of the Unknowns in Arlington Cemetery, touring the U.S. Supreme Court, the National Cathedral.

The group will also visit memorials honoring FDR, Jefferson, Lincoln, Washington, the Vietnam War and the Korean War. They will watch the United States Marine Drum and Bugle Corps and the Silent Drill Platoon perform at the Sunset Parade at Iwo Jima Memorial. Museums to be explored include the Smithsonian Institute and the Holocaust Museum(Some plans are subject to change based on governmental restrictions and availability).
